

1st and 2nd Grade Elective Choices- Fall 2009

1. Yoga (Mrs. Sullivan): Students learn a variety of yoga poses and the sun salutation, which will be combined with music.
2. Barnyard Dance (Mrs. Sibley): Students will learn a fun dance using all body parts and make animal costumes to perform it.
3. Solo Singing Fun (Mrs. Gearty): Students will learn basics of singing, practice with karaoke, and prepare a short solo performance.
4. Songs to Read (Mrs. Dodge): Students will listen to and sing Raffi songs, learning the concepts of story, sequence of events, rhyme, and rhythm.
5. Watercolor Art (Mrs. Ellefson): Students will learn the elements of Art as they design and produce a watercolor painting.
6. Rockin' Recorders (Mr. Pogatshnik): Students will learn the basics of playing the soprano recorder. They will learn simple songs using the pitches B, A, and G.
7. Lego Architecture (Mrs. Otto): Students will work to recognize the elements of Art through architecture and building with Legos.
8. You're a Poet (and You Didn't Even Know it)! (Mrs. Jacobson): Each week a different style of poetry will be explored. Each student will create personal poems and present them.
9. ST Math (Mrs. Sparks-Libby): Students will use the computer lab to play JiJi games and practice math skills.
10. The Art of Book-Making (Mrs. Follstad): Students will use their artistic skills to create a new artist's book each elective session.
